ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

<u>OF</u>

CADETS OF THE OLE WAR SKULE

STATE OF LOUISIANA

PARISH OF EAST BATON ROUGE

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, and in the presence of the two undersigned competent witnesses, personally came and appeared A. Harry Conrad and William H. Waters, who declared that, availing themselves of the Louisiana Nonprofit Corporation Law, they organize a nonprofit corporation pursuant to the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this nonprofit corporation is Cadets of the Ole War Skule ("Organization").

ARTICLE II

PURPOSES AND POWERS

The assets of the Organization shall be dedicated solely to the benefit of LSU through the support of the mission set forth in this paragraph. The mission of the Organization is to preserve and promote the contributions of LSU's military alumni to the nation by supporting the Corps of Cadets of Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College ("LSU"), fostering the heritage and traditions that are important to

LSU's military history, recognizing and honoring deserving veterans, supporting LSU patriotic events, and promoting public awareness of the value of LSU's military contributions. In furtherance of such purposes, the Organization shall have all the powers granted to nonprofit corporations under the laws of the State of Louisiana. The generality of the foregoing is limited to the extent that the Organization shall have only such purposes and shall engage in only such activities as are permissible for corporations which are exempt from income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), and which receive contributions that are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Code. Under no circumstances are any of the assets of the Organization to inure to the benefit of any other person, except that the Organization is empowered to make payments and distributions to carry out its purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the Organization shall include the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Organization shall not participate in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE III

DURATION

The Organization shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV

NONPROFIT CORPORATION

The Organization is a nonprofit corporation as defined in LSA-R.S. 12:201(7).

ARTICLE V

REGISTERED OFFICE

The registered office of the Organization is 120 Johnston Hall, Louisiana State University, Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70803.

ARTICLE VIII

<u>MEMBERSHIP</u>

The membership of the Organization shall be open to students and alumni of LSU and their spouses who meet the qualifications of membership or affiliated membership, as

set forth in the Bylaws of the Organization.

ARTICLE IX

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- A. All of the corporate powers of the Organization shall be vested in, and all of the business affairs of the Organization shall be managed by, a Board of Directors (the "Board").
- B. The Board shall have authority to exercise all such powers and to do all such lawful acts and things which the Organization might do, unless prohibited from doing so by applicable laws, by the Articles of Incorporation of the Organization, or by the Bylaws of the Organization.
- C. The number, classifications, qualifications, terms of office, manner of election, time and place of meeting, and the powers and duties of the Board shall be prescribed in the Bylaws.
- D. The names, addresses, and terms of the persons who are to serve as the initial Board of Directors of the Organization are set forth on the document attached as Exhibit "A".

ARTICLE X

BASIS OF ORGANIZATION

The Foundation is being organized on a non-stock basis.

ARTICLE XI

<u>AMENDMENT</u>

These Articles may be altered, amended or repealed and new Bylaws may be

adopted by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the Board of Directors at any regular or special meeting of the Board, the notice of which meeting shall have set forth the proposed amendment.

ARTICLE XII

DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution, liquidation or winding up of the Organization, after paying or adequately providing for its debts and obligations and otherwise returning or transferring assets as may be required by the Louisiana Nonprofit Corporation Law, all remaining assets shall be conveyed or distributed to the LSU Foundation.
